### Education Committee

### Membership Committee

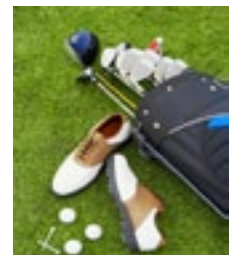
